

Thanks to the generosity of our church partners, the First Lutheran Church of Kirkland and the Kirkland UMC, as well as many others, the KFP continued to meet our mission of reducing food insecurity in our local area.

The Northern Illinois Food Bank is our primary source of food. Other items come from Rooted for Good, retailers and several food drives sponsored by schools, community groups and individuals. We received additional financial support from the

Lions Club, South Grove Township, The Red Brick Inn and many other generous people. With help from the Food Bank, we also received grant funding totaling \$7,506.87 for the purchase of food and a freezer.

The KFP had a record high number of visits in 2025 serving 186 different households including 728 individuals of which 235 were children. We helped 67 new households during 2025 and anticipate continued growth into 2026.
